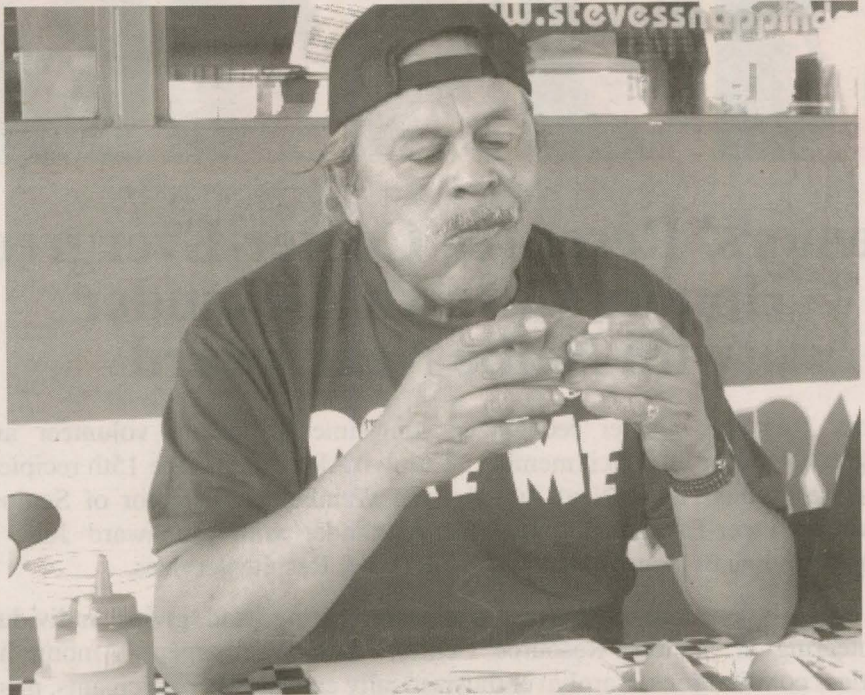

Senior Chows Down for Charity



Thornton resident, Cayetano (Sonny) de Guzman became the oldest competitor in the first-ever *Chow Down for Charity* event presented by Steve's Snappin' Dogs, 3525 E. Colfax Avenue in Denver. The event is aimed at gaining awareness and funds for Project Angel Heart and consists of qualifying events with the top two competitors at each event moving on to the finals to be hosted on July 27th in recognition of National Hot Dog Month.

The first of these four qualifying events took place on June 1st and featured de Guzman as the oldest competitor and Brady Weingardt of Denver as the youngest competitor at 21 years of age. While both kept competition close and came in third and fourth place respectively, it was 41-year-old San Wong and 33-year-old Ron Bolseth of Denver who qualified for the finals – each breaking the dog-a-minute mark. Wong ate a total of four dogs and Bolseth ate a total of three and three-quarters in the three-minute time span.
